Responding sensitively the existing Edwardian architecture, Chevron House is a new 5 bedroom family house in the creative suburb of West London.





Inspired by the architecture of the existing elegantly proportioned spaces, the design sets out to exaggerate, by scaling the space by removing walls, and attaching new space to create a large Edwardian warehouse on each of the three levels. The ground floor, the public level is essentially one space which is divided only by the use of color and material. On the second and third levels, \rightleftarrows the private floors, bedrooms merge into bathrooms and vice versa. The rear of the property has new extensions off both the living and kitchen reaching into the garden to absorb the light from the south.











The clients brief to use color extensively was applied in such that the walls and ceilings are left light in color (off white) and that only elements or interventions (joinery, etc.) would be strongly colored giving the house a lighter atmosphere with greater sense of perspective.

The client is a collector of contemporary British art and it was also an important part of the brief for Andy Martin Architects to how one may integrate it within the house.

The mission at Andy Martin Architects is to carry out ambitious building at multiple scales and programs, with a commitment to innovation, design and sustainability. They build within the city as if it is their own, and are proud of the result and conscious of the effect that their buildings have on both the city around and the inhabitants within.
