Formate Output Management Software

I would like to thank all the speakers who took time out of their busy schedules to present at our meeting in Birmingham. I would also like to thank Gordon Hancock, our Chairman, for the hospitality and superb facilities at University Hospital Birmingham.

The first presentation was a demonstration of a product we have not seen before, Formate Output Management Software. Thanks to Craig Marshall from Just Rams plc and Joe Hyde from Document Genetics.

The presentation focused on the value this product adds to a business and looked at some real life examples of how Just Rams apply two innovative Formate applications:

- 1/ Pick list automation - using barcodes to trace and capture pick lists.
- 2/ Electronic delivery of Sage statements, which incorporates the self service delivery of copy invoices.

Are stockouts affecting your delivery service levels?

Steve Tattum, Sage Product Manager, showed us how it is possible to profile stock for better service and improve cash flow forecasting. Using the tools available you can avoid the following, or similar, horror stories:

We pay for 3rd party secure warehouse storage for some promotional packaging materials and labels. The stock is never issued and increases each year - currently valued at £1.5m

Our sales staff will not confirm despatch until they have walked across the site and seen the stock for themselves.

Production has stopped for lack of a critical part. We have 'ring fenced spares stock' which cannot be released.

"I've triple checked the stock count – which number would you like?"

Steve took us through the available tools, including the END OF MONTH FORMULAE screen, how to use the inventory policy screen and the ABC Analysis method.

Sage Line 500 Wish List

Andrew Credland, Sage Research and Development, updated the delegates on the line 500 Wish List:

- How to enter wishes
- The voting list process
- Progress on Line 500 V7.1
- Demo of some of the wishes developed to date

Following the presentation, the delegates discussed some Wish List items in detail with the Sage Research & Development Team:

- Functionality to insert lines - for example, in Purchase Orders, Sales Orders, Requisitions
- Sales invoice and credit note print - add sort keys, extend consolidate options, reprint single invoices when range selected
- Enhance Release Stopped Orders - exclude forward orders, de-allocation, partial release of a line, better selection criteria, etc.
- Changes to customers on Sales Orders and suppliers on Purchase Orders - either fix so all data (eg VAT & analysis codes) is re-read and re-calculated or prevent the changes once there are lines on the order
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- SOP Shipping Note and Pick list enhancements, additional fields, re-read records when re-printing, allow re-print of single order when it has been included in a prior range selection
- Capture and report the user id and name when showing record locked messages. For instance in order entry when a product record is locked.
- Master File Auditing, add record creation date and user name to stock, customer, supplier and price list files
- Spooler management/printing enhancements: add new papers & better form layouts for better use by Paperless module, sort orders in the spool queue, etc
