1. ORDER/DELIVERY/RETURNS

- No return goods will be accepted without the prior agreement of the company. A handling charge maybe made (our errors and omissions excepted). Please refer to our "not required returns policy" a copy of which will be supplied on request. 1.2
- The company reserves the right to invoke a minimum order value if it considers it appropriate 1.3

2. PRICES

- All prices quoted are exclusive of VAT which will be charged at the rate in the force at the time of dispatch All prices are subject to change without notice and goods will be invoiced at price prevailing at the time of dispatch.

- All delivery times are quoted in good faith. The company will not be responsible for the outcome of any delays.
