## **Care Of Daler-Rowney Brushes:**

Unless brushes are given due care they will be spoiled and lose their shape. These simple rules should therefore be followed.

- Always clean your brushes after use and point up the brush hairs into their natural shape. Particular attention should be paid to ensure no paint accumulation at the ferrule.
- Keep upright never resting on their hairs or bristles. If stored for any length of time, make sure that they are thoroughly clean and dry to prevent mildew and in an airtight container to avoid moth grub attack. Use white spirit to remove oils and alkyd resin and cold water for acrylics, followed by household soap worked to a lather on the palm of the hand repeatedly until there is no further trace of colour. Rinse thoroughly and shape up the head. Stand upright and allow to dry.
- Water colour brushes should be cleaned with cold water only until all colour is extracted. Dry by stroking with a clean rag. Point brush with fingers and store upright in a dust free place.
