With a few projects lined up I embarked upon becoming a freelance web designer. I was already aware of Hove College having done extensive research into the different further study options available in Brighton and Hove, the Web Design Course offered here stood out as it covers a wide range of subjects, including creating database driven sites which was a subject I was keen to learn, as well as covering XHTML and CSS in depth which I knew from an experienced colleague in the industry are important requisites in web design today.
